

Summer Class/Camp Descriptions

Entering Grades 1-3

El Mundo de Eric Carle Camp

Come explore the world of author Eric Carle in Spanish! Through stories, such as "The Tiny Seed," "From Head to Toe," and "The Very Hungry Caterpillar," we will learn vocabulary to describe the land, body parts, days of the week, and food. This two hour camp will entail games, crafts, activities, and, of course, stories! A small snack will be provided. Each day of camp will consist of two 45-minute instructional periods with a 30-minute break in between.

Discover Spanish Class

Through games, crafts, and activities, learn the basic Spanish vocabulary for school supplies, numbers, and telling time. Class is 45 minutes.

Entering Grades 4-6

Let's Taco 'Bout It! Camp

This camp is a great introduction to the Spanish language and culture! Let's taco 'bout sports, food, and the weather! Through age-appropriate games and activities we will learn and practice these common conversational topics. Each day of camp will consist of two 45-minute instructional periods with a 30-minute break in between. A small snack will be provided.

Middle School/High School

Each day of camp will consist of two 45-minute instructional periods with a 30-minute break in between. A small snack will be provided.

Spanish 1 Review/Intro to Spanish 1 Entering Grades 9-12

This class is perfect for students needing a Spanish 1 refresher course over the summer or for students wanting a head start on learning material covered in Spanish 1 at the high school level. Each class will focus on a different grammar skill and vocabulary theme that is taught in Unit 5's Spanish 1 curriculum. There will be no tests or homework.

Adult

Beginning Spanish 1B

In this follow-up class to Beginning Spanish 1, we will learn about -er/-ir verbs, tener, the calendar, weather, possessive adjectives, clothing, colors, estar with adjectives, physical characteristics, and direct object pronouns. This class will be mostly online through videos and workbook activities. There will be periodic in-person classes to practice listening and speaking and to review material that was learned independently. Prerequisite is Beginning Spanish 1 or equivalent.
