Beginning Spanish 1

- Greetings/Introductions

Spanish Review and Conversation

This class will alternate weeks of in-person and independent instruction. In-person classes will focus on speaking while also allowing for clarification on the previous week's work. During asynchronous weeks, students will receive instructional videos and homework to complete independently. In this class students will review:

- present tense verbs, including irregulars
- ser vs. estar
- direct and indirect object pronouns
- tú commands
- reflexive verbs
- comparisons
- possessive adjectives

Beginning Spanish 1 B

- er/-ir verbs, tener
- the calendar
- weather
- possessive adjectives
- clothing and colors
- estar with adjectives
- physical characteristics
- direct object pronouns

Beginning Spanish 1 B (Remote Only)

Topics covered will be the same as the in-person 1B class. This class will meet on Zoom with live instruction and student interaction on 6/4, 6/11, 6/18, and 6/23. On 6/18, 6/25, and 7/16, students will receive video instruction and assignments in lieu of Zoom.

Spanish 3

This class will alternate weeks of in-person and independent instruction. In-person classes will focus on speaking while also allowing for clarification on the previous week's work. During asynchronous weeks, students will receive instructional videos and homework to complete independently. In this class, students will:

- review the preterite and imperfect
- combine the preterite and imperfect
- learn demonstrative adjectives
- learn ordinal numbers
- expand vocabulary
